## Food

Lunch will be paid during registration on site. It will be held at the headquarters and drinks will also be sold.

## Registration

Please register at the headquarters after you arrived there. You can also do this on Friday between 12:30 pm and 05:00 pm. You will have to be registered on site at Saturday 08:45 am latest. Otherwise you will not be able to participate at the tournament.

## Doubles

There will be a small doubles tournament on Friday. The playerfee is 5€ per team and all fees will be going to the 100% pay-out. You can start at noon until 4:30 pm latest. The whole course will be played in the best-shot format. The final doubles standings will be published at the headquarters on Saturday. If your team won some cash, please come by and pick it up until after the price ceremony latest. If you or your teammate didn't pick up the cash until then, it will be regarded as a donation to Heads Up Freiburg.

## Meeting & Score Pick-Up

A players meeting will only be held on Saturday morning. We will only hold another meeting if extreme causes make this necessary. A lot of rain will be one cause for example. We do not plan further meetings right now. The flights will be published at the headquarters with more than enough head start. Please remember that the first person named on the flight is responsible to pick up the score book. Don't forget this, because we have long walkways to the different holes.

### Lost Disc

Nearly the complete course is located in the woods. It is highly possible that you need to search for your disc for a longer period of time. Please remember the PDGA rules with the 3 minutes time limit. After this time the disc is regarded as lost and you will need to re-throw. We have a real thin timetable, so please keep to those rules.

### Format & Cuts

The Heuweilermer Dorf Challenge use a format that is not well known in Germany. Instead of playing a semi-final, we play an extended open final with the top 8 open players. All other divisions will play a top 4 final at the same time.

If there will be different holes for the finals, it will be published at the headquarters at Sunday morning latest.

### Tournament headquarters

The tournament headquarters are **not** located right at the course. You will need to walk to every tee and the longest path will take you about 15 minutes. Please keep that in mind when you walk to your first tee. There are also a lot of up and down paths, so it is better to plan a little more time.

### Course information

#### Terrain

Our course is not in a public park or anything like it. It is in the middle of a forest that is somewhat taken care of. This means that there are branches laying mostly everywhere, besides on the fairways, and sometimes even some trees. You will have to be very careful while walking in the rough. You will certainly need some stout shoes because the area is far from flat.

#### Ticks

There are always some ticks around in Heuweiler. So we recommend to use some tick repellent. We will provide some of it at the headquarters, if you do not have any. Please also check yourself after the day and certainly do not ignore this warning. Getting bitten by a tick does happen quite a lot at our course.

#### Water

We will provide some water at the tee of hole 6 and hole 1. Take as much as you need, but keep in mind your fellow players who might want to refill their bottles as well.
